22	MR. JEFF MACKEY: All right. So a	
23	little background. On January 8th, a declaration	
24	of intent to be a write-in candidate for Kathleen

Radcliff was dropped off at our office by Joe Healy. The 8th was the deadline, so it met the deadline.

On January 12th, a protest against the declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate was filed by Alex Pavloff, who is a qualified elector in Columbus Ward 8. The 12th was the deadline for that filing, so that was timely as well.

On her declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate, Kathleen Radcliff declares that her qualifying voting residence address is 175 South Third Street, Columbus 43215.

She is additionally registered to vote at 175 South Third Street, Apartment 100, Columbus 43215.

That registration -- that change of registration came in on -- or was processed on 11 -- November 21st of 2020. You may have a copy of that there; I think. Does everybody have that?

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Which piece were you suggesting?

MR. JEFF MACKEY: You may not have that in your packet here. So one side of that is

her voter records, showing the change of address on November 22nd -- or I'm sorry, 21st of 2020. And then the other side is the actual registration that was filed.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Wait. I'm sorry, because we were passing -- will you walk us back to the beginning of the voter registration?

MR. JEFF MACKEY: Sure. That's the voter registration, and then if you flip it over, you'll see that the top section there -- if you flip that over, the top section there is kind of our record. You can see that the change was processed on November 21st of 2020.

DIRECTOR WHITE: The highlighted section.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: From?

MR. JEFF MACKEY: A different address. And she has also voted multiple times from that address. You can see that at the bottom of that other side.

On the one side a voter registration card from 10-8. Is that '21? On Bellows? I'm still not following you. Sorry for my density today, but

5 1 what are we saying with this document? 2 MR. JEFF MACKEY: It's just the last 3 voter registration that we got from her that put her at the 175 South Third Street address. That's 4 5 the one that's in your hand there. 6 MEMBER SEXTON: Is that the one --7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay, I see; old 8 value, new value. 9 MEMBER MARINELLO: She moved from 10 Bellows to Third, she said. 11 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. 12 MEMBER SEXTON: And that was on 13 11-21-2020? 14 MR. JEFF MACKEY: That's when we put 15 it in. That would have been -- there was an 16 election in November of that year, so I don't know 17 how long we had it before it got processed --CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So this is in 18 19 Updating my Address, and you're saying that this 20 document, Updating my Address 10 -- or 10-8-21 was 21 entered in our system --2.2 DIRECTOR WHITE: Yeah, because 23 during that period, the registration would have

24

been on hold, because it would have been after the

6 1 deadline to register to vote, so it was held until 2 after the election and then it was processed. 3 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. And then this document was entered on 11-21-20. That's 4 2020, not 2021. 5 6 DIRECTOR WHITE: Correct. 7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So that -- the 8 way she wrote that, it looks like a one, but I see 9 this is zero. Okay. 10 MR. JEFF MACKEY. All right. 11 once we received the protest, the Board promptly 12 set the time and place of the hearing to be held 13 today, and notice was mailed to both parties on 14 January 18th. 15 The protester has joined us today. 16 I believe he will likely walk you through the document that he filed with us. 17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. 18 19 MEMBER MARINELLO: Ms. Radcliff is 20 not here? 21 MR. JEFF MACKEY: No. 22 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Do you want 23 to ask Alex to come up? 24 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yeah.

1 Radcliff, nor representation for her, is here. 2 have Mr. Pavloff here. If you would like to speak. 3 It's our tradition -- or requisite to have you 4 sworn in by the court reporter, please. 5 MR. PAVLOFF: I'm happy to. 6 (Mr. Pavloff sworn in.) 7 MR. PAVLOFF: Good afternoon. My name is Alex Pavloff. I'm a candidate for the 8 9 Republican party of Franklin County Central Committee, Columbus Ward 8. 10 11 I filed a protest against my 12 opponent, who I believe is voting from a commercial 13 address, not her residential address. 14 Before we get started, do you all 15 have copies of my protest letter in front of you? I brought some in case --16 17 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: This is the 18 January 12th? 19 MR. PAVLOFF: Yes. 20 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I think we do. 21 MR. PAVLOFF: Very good. I'm just 2.2 going to run through that real quick, and any 23 questions you have, I'm happy to answer to the best 24 of my ability.

So I've got a few pieces of evidence contained in this letter. The first of which are some screenshots from the Caldwell Banker, which was originally King Thompson real estate website, listing Ms. Radcliff, as well as her partners in the real estate business, all with their office address at 175 South Third Street, Suite 100, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

You can see -- and this isn't even the entirety of the folks that are working for that real estate firm that listed their address, but you can see just the sheer number of folks that are listing that as their place of business.

Following that, I've got some screenshots from the Franklin County Auditor's website, which detailed that this property is exclusively commercial. I've got kind of the first page that lists the property, and you can see down there at the bottom, 2023 tax status, property class, C, commercial.

The next page is from a section of the website detailing any residential zoning for the building. You can see there is no data there. And then following that, we've got essentially the

commercial page detail, detailing that there are, in fact, offices there, and that it is -- the tax status is commercial.

Finally, I submitted to you guys a notarized statement for myself, swearing that the screenshots contained were captured in their original native form, without editing aside from cropping of size, and in an attempt to not exclude any pertinent information.

I also had a conversation the morning of January 11, as I was checking out the property with some folks that worked the front desk there, 175 South Third. Casual conversation.

Asked them if there were any residential units in the building, and they said no. So I've detailed that here as well.

I attempted to reach out to the property -- I'm sorry; there was some confusion on the hearing date. No big deal, but I attempted to reach out to the property themselves to see if they would send somebody or a letter. They did not get back to me in a timely fashion, so my apologies for not having that piece of evidence here with me as well.

10 1 With that, any questions you have, 2 I'm happy to answer. 3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: Questions from the Board? 4 5 MEMBER SEXTON: I just wanted to clarify, for staff, but according to this record 6 7 we've been given that Ms. Radcliff registered to vote at this address on 11-21-2020? 8 9 MR. JEFF MACKEY: That's correct. MEMBER SEXTON: And it looks like 10 11 you have here she's voted there for, it looks like, 12 about three years, in six elections? 13 DIRECTOR WHITE: That's correct. MEMBER SEXTON: 21 -- once in '21, 14 15 General. It looks like both Primaries in 2022, 16 General in '22. I assume that's the special, '23, 17 and the General in '23. So she's established the 18 last three years of history of voting at this 19 address. 20 MR. JEFF MACKEY: That's correct. 21 MEMBER SEXTON: So I just wanted to 2.2 confirm that with staff. 23 Okay. And, Mr. Pavloff, you're

12 | March 19th Primary election, and I'll call on Carla

Patton, who is our manager in the operations

department.

MS. CARLA PATTON: Good afternoon.

16 First, Exhibit A, you have in your packet is the

paper allocations that we're recommending for this

18 | Primary election.

Typically, you go to a previous like election for your -- for our comparison to get our numbers; however, previous like election was not a real good measure for us, which would have been the 2020 Primary because of the nature of everything going on, the extension of the election, and

2.2

everything done by mail, essentially.

Rather, instead for this elections allocation, we are reverting back to the 2016 Primary election results to come up with the numbers.

So per Section 5.07 in the election official manual from the Secretary of State's office, provisional ballots must equal five percent more than the number of provisional ballots cast in the like election.

So we have done -- we have taken the five -- we have taken the provisionals from the 2016 Primary election and added an additional five percent to that number.

Then that number was then rounded up to the nearest increment -- rounded up to the nearest increment of 25, since pads are sent out in packs of 25 ballots.

For the election day, paper by choice for backup ballots. Our method allows for our Board to have the discretion on how many ballots we provide to our voting locations.

This election, we've used ten percent of the Primary ballots cast on election day

at the polls in 2016 Primary, and then we've, again, have rounded that up to the nearest increment of 25, and then we've added that to the pads of provisional ballots.

And that is the number that you see before you on Exhibit A. So that -- the numbers before you represents the provisional requirement, as well as the election day paper by choice allocations that we're recommending for this election.

We do have the ability to print on demand here in the office in the event that any location were to be running short on ballots on election day, and we are able to turn those around and get those out in a timely manner without interruption to voting.

With the allocations before you, there's a total of 65,525 ballots, both for Democratic and Republican parties. And then only 96 ballot styles this election will have an issue on them, and so the issues only balance, we have allocated 3,775 ballots to be going out on election day.

So we would ask that you adopt this

- allocation plan that is set before you and not Exhibit A.
 - CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Why am I surprised that 65,525 is the same for both ours and these, when I would have thought that these would have been higher.
 - MS. CARLA PATTON: Because we have open -- our voters can declare either party at the polls on election day. So rather than drilling it down to a specific number on the party level, we allow -- we make sure we have ample ballots available for voters, regardless of which party they would choose on election day.
 - MEMBER MARINELLO: I move that the Board adopt the paper ballot allocation formula in Exhibit A compiled by the Board staff for the March 19th Primary Election.

I'll ask Carla to remain up there as we do the allocation for voting machines and Touch Pads.

MS. CARLA PATTON: Again, before you is Exhibit B, which is the initial voting equipment and EPB allocations for the March 19th, 2024 Primary Election.

This is based on location level, not precinct. So as you can see, the ballot counters or the DS 200, we've got allocated one for every 2,550 voters, with at least one in every location.

The express vote tabletops or the ballot marker that sit on the tables have been allocated, one per 350 voters, with a minimum of two in any location.

The kiosk, express kiosk, which is our ADA ballot markers, have been allocated one for every 4,600 voters, or roughly one for every 13 tabletop markers, with a minimum of one at any location. And we always -- I would also like to note that those machines can be used by any voter,

regardless of whether they're ADA or not.

So -- and then you have a column for the total express votes, which is a combination of the tabletop and kiosks, with a minimum of three marking devices at any location.

This election, we are bringing back the electronic poll books again. We have the Touch Pads from GENEX, and so that allocation now is back on to our equipment allocations for the election.

Touch Pads for this election have been allocated one for every 125 voters, with a minimum of three Touch Pads in any voting location. So the total that we're looking at, there will be 501 ballot counters deployed. 2,679 express vote tabletops.

of 3,3- -- or 3,033 express votes at the polls, and 1,314 Touch Pads, all within 30 -- 304 voting locations for this election.

I would ask that you adopt the plans set before you for the equipment allocation in Exhibit B.

CARLA PATTON: In order to meet the requirements for the elections this year, to 14 15 allow our voters to cast ballots on the ballot 16 marking devices, we were in need of the ballot 17 cards, the thermal ballot cards from Election Systems and Software in order to be able to send 18 19 out enough to the locations to ensure that every 20 voter has the ability to cast their vote when 21 they're there. 2.2 In order for us to meet that 23 requirement, an order for 1.5 million ballot cards 24 was placed with Election Systems and Software at

just under \$.14 apiece, for a total of \$202,500, with shipping at about \$2,200, for a total of \$204,700.

This is the only -- we get these from ES&S as a sole source vendor, and they are wrapped in packs of 25 to allow for our poll workers to easily account for and count those out by the end of the day, at the closing of the polls.

So we would ask that you approve the purchase of the 1.5 million ballot cards.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: What was the reference to the thermal technology?

MS. CARLA PATTON: They're single-sided thermal, and they're specific cut designs that the machine -- it has to have a certain cut to the -- at a certain angle for the machine to recognize the card, and the fact then that they're wrapped in packs of 25 for us versus larger packs of 250.

MEMBER MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I move the Board purchase 1.5 million ballot cards from the Election Systems and Software for \$204,700, for use in the 2024 Primary and General Elections.
