3 1 Are there any questions? 2 MEMBER SEXTON: Mr. Chairman, I move 3 that the Board approve the minutes from the January 2nd, 2024 meeting of the Franklin County Board of 4 5 Elections they have submitted. 6 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I second the 7 motion. DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been 8 9 properly moved and seconded. 10 All those in favor of the motion, 11 signify by saying aye. 12 (Vote taken.) 13 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, same sign. 14 15 (No response.) 16 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The motion carries. 17 The next item on the Agenda is the 18 19 paper ballot allocation for the March 19th primary 20 election, and I will call on Carla Patton, our 21 manager of operations, to go through that. 2.2 MS. CARLA PATTON: Good afternoon. 23 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Good afternoon. 24 MS. CARLA PATTON: Before you is

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Exhibit A, which is the paper ballot allocations for the 2024 March primary election. From the last reading of the last Board meeting, there were no changes to the allocations. The formulas have stayed the same.

We went back to the 2016 primary election as a means for our comparison to get our numbers. The allocations before you do meet the requirements for the provisional ballots requirement that is set forth per the Ohio State Election Official Manual from the Secretary of State's office, which is the number of provisionals in the previous like election, plus five percent of that number. Then we round it up to 25. The nearest increment of 25 from there.

And it also includes ten percent of the ballots cast in the previous election, which, again, we use the 2016 primary for the election day backup ballots, and those, again, then are rounded up to the next increment of 25.

The allocations before you represent that there will be 65,525 Democratic ballots, Republican ballots, and then 3,775 issued on the ballots that will go out on election day.

5 And as a reminder, we do have the ability to print on demand in house in the event that a location runs short on election day and we can get those out in a short turnaround time. CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I don't see any instances -- are there instances where the allocation for Democratic ballots and Republican ballots are different? MS. CARLA PATTON: No; we kept those the same across the board since voters have the ability to select whichever party they choose on election day, whether they change parties from a previous election or not, we can't make that determination as to -- we just want to show up and issue the same number of ballots per party. MEMBER MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I

MEMBER MARINELLO: Mr. Chairman, I move that the Board adopt the paper ballot allocation formula in Exhibit A compiled by the Board staff for the March 19th primary election.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Second the

motion.

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DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been moved and seconded.

All those in favor of the motion,

6 1 signify by saying aye. 2 (Vote taken.) 3 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, 4 the same sign? 5 (No response.) 6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The motion 7 carries. 8 While you're up there, Carla, if you 9 wouldn't mind going through the voting machine and touch pad allocation for the same primary election. 10 11 MS. CARLA PATTON: So Exhibit B is 12 the equipment allocations for the March 2024 13 primary election. Again, there were no changes as a result of voter registration numbers, so in the 14 15 formulas that remained the same with ballot 16 counters allocated one per 2,550 voters, with at 17 least one in any location. 18 Express vote tabletops are one for 19 every 350 voters, with no less than two. Then each 20 location has a minimum of one of the ADA express 21 votes in the kiosk, and that equates for every 13 2.2 tabletop markers allocated, they get an additional 23 kiosk ballot marker. So there's a total of no less 24 than three express votes in any given location.

1 Also, on that allocation is the 2 touch pads. Our electronic poll books, and those 3 have been allocated for one for every 125 voters, with a minimum of three at any location. 5 So on election day, we will be 6 deploying 501 ballot counters, 2,679 express vote 7 tabletops, 354 express vote kiosks, for a total of 3,033 express votes, and 1,314 touch pads, all 8 9 going to 304 voting locations. 10 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Okay. Questions? 11 MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Mr. Chairman, I 12 move that the Board adopt the voting machine and 13 touch pad allocation formula in Exhibit B, compiled by the Board staff, for the March 19th primary 14 election. 15 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: I'll second. 16 17 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been 18 properly moved and seconded. 19 All those in favor of the motion, 20 signify by saying aye. 21 (Vote taken.) 2.2 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: All opposed, 23 same sign. 24 (No response.)

9 1 in that particular precinct. 2 MEMBER SEXTON: Right, but if the 3 ward -- like Ward 66, where a Democratic candidate has already withdrawn, so when they go in, they'll 4 5 see -- you know, they'll see that name and then any -- whatever district candidates --6 7 MR. JEFF MACKEY: Every candidate that has withdrawn. They're not specific to that 8 9 precinct. 10 MEMBER SEXTON: So they're in -- the first one we're looking at is in Dublin, so all of 11 12 those -- will all of those be listed on all the Columbus precincts or --13 14 MR. JEFF MACKEY: Yes. 15 MEMBER SEXTON: Okay. Any other 16 questions? 17 I move that the Board accept the withdrawal of Kathy Harter for Republican County 18 19 Central Committee, Dublin Ward 1; Chris Cooper for 20 Democrat County Central Committee, Columbus Ward 21 54; Felicity Beck for Democrat County Central 22 Committee, Worthington Ward 1; Lloyd Blake for 23 Democrat County Central Committee, Columbus Ward 24 66; Kathy Green, for Democrat County Central

Is that --6 MR. JEFF MACKEY: Oh, that list is 7 cumulative. There are six new withdrawals --8 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Oh, that's 9 cumulative? So -- okay. Understood. I understand you said that. You said that. Second the motion. 10 11 MR. PAYNE: It's been properly moved 12 and seconded. 13 All those in favor of the motion, signify by saying aye. 14 15 (Vote taken.) 16 All opposed, same sign? 17 (No response.) DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The motion 18 19 carries. 20 The next item on the Agenda, I would 21 like to call up Steve Bulen, who is the manager of 2.2 our Precinct Election Officials Organization, to 23 discuss the Election Support Specialist Program

briefly.

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MR. STEVE BULEN: Thank you Deputy Director Payne. Good afternoon, Mr. Chairman and members of the Board. I believe that the best description of the election support specialist position is summed up in the directors and deputy director's goal for the program, which is to professionalize our approach to assisting poll workers and provide them with the best customer service that we can each election cycle.

We piloted this program during the 2023 November general election at 75 different voting locations throughout the county and scheduled 25 election support specialists, who were responsible to provide support to three different voting locations for poll workers during Monday night setup and also on election day.

Based on the success of the pilot project and the feedback that we received from both poll workers and the election support specialists themselves, we decided to expand the program and provide support to every voting location during the upcoming March 19th primary.

Election support specialists will be taking the place of day drivers, a position that

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has been in place for several elections. We're building on the solid successful foundation of that program, while increasing the scope and amount of training that the election support specialists receives, thus positioning them to be able to assist in a broader way of situations that our poll workers face, both on Monday night and election day.

For instance, day drivers receive three to four hours of hands-on training, whereas the election support specialist team receives more than 30 hours of hands-on and online training. All of this after they have submitted a resume, successfully completed a phone and in-person interview.

From the genesis of this program, we believe that Laurie Gatton would do an excellent job in helping to develop and lead it. We added Josiah Lanning to the team, and through Laurie's leadership, they navigated us through a successful project.

This election, we added Donell Fernandez, our college intern, to the team, and over the last two weekends, working with Chris

13 1 Fender and some of our PO trainers, we trained our 2 first group of election support specialists, and 3 over the next two weekends, the second group will be trained, giving us a total of 96 election 5 support specialists ready to be a part of professionalizing our approach and providing our 6 7 poll workers with the best customer service we can. 8 I look forward to seeing this 9 program continue to grow through Laurie's 10 leadership and improve over the next several 11 elections. 12 Mr. Chairman and Members of the 13 Board, I thank you for providing me the opportunity to share this information. Thanks. 14 15 MEMBER MARINELLO: Do they go 16 through a background check --17 MR. STEVE BULEN: Yes. Yes. 18 they do. CHAIRMAN PREISSE: So 96 19 20 individuals? 21 MR. STEVE BULEN: Correct. 2.2 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Are they all 23 going to do three --24 MR. STEVE BULEN: Some of them will

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     need to do four this time around in order to cover
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     the three of the four locations.

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15 1 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Good. Great. 2 Any other counties doing this, as far as we know? 3 MR. STEVE BULEN: Not that I'm aware. Not to this degree. 4 5 MS. MARINELLO: We're always the best. 6 7 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: We're always the 8 best. 9 DIRECTOR WHITE: I mean, there's 10 probably some sort of program like this in place or 11 things of that nature. We really wanted to expand 12 what we do, in terms of support, and not just have 13 runners who have applied, but have people who have expertise that can help on election day. 14 15 We ask our poll workers to do a lot, 16 and they get expert training, but, obviously, with 17 so much going on, this is just an additional way for them to receive support out in the field, as 18 19 well as being able to call back here on our 20 hotline. 21 So we're really excited about this 22 program. We're excited about the job that Steve 23 and Laurie have done so far, and we look forward to

this program continuing to grow.

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CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Right. And these folks, in terms of the communication, they're a part of the network of mass communication, and they've got the hotline to call --

MR. STEVE BULEN: That is correct.

Laurie's team will have eight dispatchers assigned to the various election support specialists out there, so commun -- two-way communication back and forth is always available.

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Super.

mentioned Laurie Gatton, and she's been with us for a number of years, working in the Precinct Election Officials Department. She took this program on and has conducted all of the interviews, set up the interviews, developed the training, and actually, with some other trainers, delivers the training.

so with all of her increased responsibilities, I thought it would be -- along with our whole team here, I thought it would be appropriate to give Laurie a pay raise, taking her to \$28.75 an hour. Laurie is in the back. I think most of you know Laurie.

MEMBER FREEDHOFF: Chairman, because

17 1 of the increased responsibilities of coordinating 2 the Election Support Specialist Program, I move 3 that the Board authorize the pay raise for Laurie Gatton, taking her to \$28.75. MEMBER MARINELLO: I second. 5 6 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's been properly moved and seconded. All those in favor of 7 8 the motion, signify by saying aye. 9 (Vote taken.) 10 All opposed, same sign. 11 (No response.) 12 DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: The motion 13 carries. 14 Congratulations, Laurie. 15 There isn't anything else on the 16 Agenda, but we do have a member of the public that 17 would like to address the Board. Her name is Karen Rankin. 18 19 At the pleasure of the chairman, do 20 we want to --21 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: She's a member of 2.2 the public, who is familiar to us, who wants a 23 minute or two to share some thoughts, which we're 24 happy to entertain and listen.

MS. RANKIN: Good afternoon, and thank you for allowing me to bring up this point.

As a poll worker, I'm a machine judge, and I've gone through the training for several years, and I have noticed in the past few years, when --

CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Did you introduce yourself?

MS. RANKIN: Oh, no, I did not.

I am Karen Rankin, citizen, resident of Columbus, Ohio, and I would also -- I work as a poll worker during election time, and I have noticed that in the last couple years, since we have to present as voters, photo ID, that I have noticed the place I had been working, that the staff, the roster judges, have not been asking to see the faces of people who are wearing masks.

And when I brought this to the attention of the BLM one day, she said, "Well, we weren't told we had to do that," and so I brought it up again to some friends, and then they suggested I talk to the Secretary of State,

Secretary of State, Mr. Frank LaRose.

And so I called his office and

talked to someone on the phone, and he got back with me with the question — to answer the question that I had about do the roster judges need to see the faces of people who are wearing masks to make sure that the ID — the photo ID that they are carrying and presenting is a picture of the person presenting it, and she said that would be left — basically left up to the Board of Elections and the County.

And so I'm bringing up this here because I have noticed, and I have talked to voters who are wearing masks as I'm escorting them to the machines to vote, "Has anyone -- did your roster person who was registering you in, do they ask to see your face?" "No."

Then I talked to a voter who was depositing their ballot into the ballot counter.

"Did anybody at the roster table, ask to see your face when you presented your photo ID?" "No."

And so I'm thinking this is a problem, especially when I have seen the people who are wearing masks not removing it for a moment so the roster judge can see. And the fact that the

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- 1 vote -- one of the voters said, "No, they didn't 2 ask?
 - MEMBER MARINELLO: Are you talking about a COVID mask? The masks for COVID?
- MS. RANKIN: Yes, like, you know, COVID -- for people who are still wearing them for 6 7 COVID reasons.

And so, basically, I was told by the voters themselves that no one has asked them to, you know -- not to remove them forever, just to say, "Yes, I'm the person on that photo."

So that's what I wanted to bring up for you, and the fact that in the training manual, on Page 72, it -- if you can get there -- 72. It says at the top of the page, "A guide to valid photo IDs. A photo ID is valid if it's OPEN." The word OPEN is capitalized as a -- I've forgotten the word.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR PAYNE: It's an acronym.

MS. RANKIN: Thank you very much. Acronym. An acronym. O starts -- stands for Ohio resident, P stands for person matches photo, E, not expired, N, name matches name in touch pad.

21 1 So I'm just going to just say I just 2 can't believe that the person wearing a mask --3 "Oh, I can see their eyes. I can tell," is what I have been told by some. I'm thinking people of the 5 same family sometimes have the same eye color and that sort of thing. 6 7 So just bringing this before your attention that if the manual says what they're 8 9 supposed to do, perhaps they should. Thank you. CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Questions for --10 11 Karen? 12 MS. RANKIN: Yes. 13 CHAIRMAN PREISSE: Yes, Karen. Questions for Karen? 14 15 Well, thank you.
