- Weekdays, July 10th through July 27th from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Final week, July 30th through August 3rd from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, August 4th from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, August 5th from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Monday, August 6th from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
