### **Countdown is on to May 3<sup>rd</sup> Primary Election**

**(Columbus)** Franklin County registered voters have six days to cast in-person absentee ballots for the Primary Election. Figures released by the Board of Elections today show more than 11,000 registered Franklin County voters have either returned their voted mail-in ballot or voted in-person at our early vote center at 1700 Morse Road.

### **Early voting continues at 1700 Morse Road through next Monday, see times below:**

Wednesday, April 27<sup>th</sup> - 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. through Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>

Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup> - 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Sunday, May 1<sup>st</sup> - 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> - 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

If you have already requested an absentee ballot and plan on hand delivering to the Board of Elections, it must be received at 1700 Morse Road by 7:30 p.m. on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Completed absentee ballots cannot be delivered to any of the county's 320 Election Day voting locations. If mailed, it must be post marked by Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 and received by the Board of Elections no later than Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 to be counted.

Election Day is Tuesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. Polls open at 6:30 a.m. and will remain open until 7:30 p.m.
