Board of Elections Certify Candidates and Issues for May 2, 2023 Primary/Special Election

(Columbus) Yesterday, the Franklin County Board of Elections certified candidates and issues for the May 2, 2023 Primary/Special Election. A total of 6 candidates and 14 local options throughout the county were certified to the May ballot. Another 43 candidates were also certified to the November 7, 2023 General Election. The Board of Elections checked over 30,000 signatures in the petition process.

Only two communities the City of Gahanna and the City of Hilliard will have candidates on the ballot to vote on for the May 2 Primary/Special Election.

Voters in the below precincts in Franklin County will have local options on the ballot to decide.
