Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio, passed on the 8th day of July, 2021, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of Bexley at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting, on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 2021, the question of shall the proposed revisions to the City of Bexley Charter stating that the City of Bexley rejects all forms of racism, discrimination, anti-Semitism and all hate-based conduct, and expresses the City of Bexley's intent to embrace diversity and work to confront racism and discrimination; to strive to ensure no person or group engaged with the City is a victim of discrimination and to require the City's Strategic Plan to incorporate strategies to eliminate discrimination and increase diversity; to commit to diversity in hiring and contracting; to interpret ordinances to avoid discrimination; and to modify language in the Charter to use gender neutral pronouns be approved?

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
