

PROCLAMATION

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

OHIO REVISED CODE § 3501.03

The Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio, issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.

A GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2025, at the usual places of holding elections in this County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following offices:


Judges of the Franklin County Municipal Court; City Offices – City Attorney (where applicable), City Auditor (where applicable), and Members of Council; Village Offices – Members of Council, Member of Board of Trustees of Public Affairs (Village of Urbancrest only); Township Fiscal Officer (unexpired term ending 3/31/27 in Mifflin and Washington); Township Trustee (2 positions); Members of Governing Boards of Educational Service Centers; Members of Boards of Education.

And for the purpose of deciding the following questions and issues:

Franklin County ADAMH – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal and increase); Columbus Zoo – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal); City of Canal Winchester – Proposed Charter Amendments; City of Columbus – Proposed Bond Issues; City of Obetz – Proposed Income Tax; City of Westerville – Citizen Initiated Charter Amendment; City of Whitehall – 3 Referendums and a Citizen Initiated Ordinance; Village of Minerva Park – Proposed Tax Levy (renewal); Village of Riverlea – Proposed Tax Levies Current Expenses (replacement with decrease) and Streets (replacement with decrease); Blendon Township (unincorporated area) – Proposed Police Levy (additional); Franklin Township (unincorporated area) – Proposed Fire Levy (renewal with increase); Jackson Township – Proposed Fire Levy (renewal); Township (unincorporated area) – Proposed Police Levy (additional); Jonathan Alder Local School District – Proposed Bond Issue; Olentangy Local School District – Proposed Bond Issue; Westerville City School District - Proposed Income Tax; and local option questions in Columbus 27-D, 30-E, 31-C, 35-C, 40-A, 40-C, 60-E, Grove City 5-D, Obetz-A, Westerville 1-A, 3-A, and 5-B
