WESTERVILLE SPECIAL ELECTION TOMORROW

(Columbus)- Westerville voters will head to the polls tomorrow for a special election to decide on a proposed tax levy to benefit the Westerville Public Library. Fifty-nine precincts will be open in the Westerville City School District.

The levy proposes a replacement tax to cover current library expenses of 0.8 mills per year for five years beginning in 2007 with the first payment due in 2008. If approved, the levy would cost property owners eight cents per \$100 of valuation.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Voters can find the location of their polling place by calling the Franklin County Board of Elections at 462-3100 or by visiting the Board of Elections' Web site at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov/boe>. Election results will also be posted on the Web site after the polls close Tuesday evening.
