

2.4 After the first full cycle of monitoring, the monitoring of Executive Limitations policies will be included on the agenda for separate discussion only if CEO reports indicate non-compliance, if a majority of the Board has questions about CEO compliance or reasonable interpretation, or if policy content is to be debated. Otherwise EL monitoring reports will be included in the consent agenda.

2.5 . The board will direct, control, and inspire the district through the careful establishment of written policies reflecting the Board's values and perspectives. The Board's major policy focus will be on the intended long-term benefits for students, not on the administrative or programmatic means of attaining those benefits

2.6 Continuous Board development will include orientation of candidates for the Board and new members of the Board about the Board's governance process and periodic discussion and evaluation of the Board's processes to assure continued improvement.
