CANON 7 (C) (2) (a) (ii)

The campaign committee shall not knowingly receive directly or indirectly for any political

Or personal purpose any of the following:

A contribution from any appointee of the court unless the campaign committee, on its campaign contribution and expenditure statement, reports the name, address, occupation, and employer of the appointee, identifies the person as an appointee of the court, and indicates whether the appointee, in the current year or in any of the previous six calendar years, received aggregate compensation from court appointments in excess of two hundred fifty dollars.

As treasurer of the campaign committee, I have made my best efforts to identify appointees of the court of Common Pleas, Franklin County, Ohio, and have noted those contributors with an asterisk (*); however, there are seventeen (17) judges of the General Division (Criminal and Civil), five (5) judges of the Juvenile/Domestic Relations Division, and one (1) judge of the Probate Division in the Court of Common Pleas, Franklin County, Ohio, any one of whom may have appointed an individual to any duty or representation required by law and received compensation in excess of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), over the previous six calendar years required by Canon 7 of the Code of Judicial Conduct. Any error or omission is mine and will be corrected by amendment when informed.
