First Week Absentee Demand Ahead of 2012 Pace

(Columbus) The latest numbers from the Franklin County Board of Elections show absentee ballot requests running ahead of comparable figures from the presidential primary in 2012.

Totals at the start of today's voting show 15, 516 requesting ballots by mail and 1,314 voting in-person at the board of elections compared to 7,688 asking for mailed ballots and 304 voting in-person four years ago.
